

Step 1: Add the green food coloring to the frosting and let the kids mix it up.


Step 2: Put the ice cream cones upside down on a disposal plate

#### **Judy's Warm Cocoa Recipe**



#### **Ingredients:**

2 Cups of Milk

1 Cup of Dark Chocolate Chips

14 a Cup of Sugar

1/3 Cup Instant Nonfat Dry Milk

**¼ Teaspoon Vanilla Extract** 

1/4 Teaspoon Cinnamon

**Pinch of Salt** 

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Pour % Cup of Milk into a medium sized saucepan and place on a medium heat. Make sure the milk doesn't boil or get too hot.
- 2. Add in cup of chocolate chips, with a few extra for good measure. Mix until the chocolate has melted fully into the milk.
- 3. Add in the vanilla, sugar, cinnamon and salt. Mix.
- 4. Pour the rest of the milk into the mixture, and add the instant dry milk. Mix.
- 5. Put the saucepan cover on the saucepan, and have a grownup shake the ingredients together for 5 seconds.
- 6. Choose a good mug, and fill it with your cocoa.
- 7. Enjoy!

#### **Super Secret Step #8:**

If you have a few regular sized marshmallows, tear them in half, and put them on top of your cocoa. Old Fashioned Whipped Cream or Mini-Marshmallows will do the trick too.







## The Grinch's Lump of Coal Recipe!



## **Ingredients You Will Need:**

16 oz. of Oreo Cookies

4 Cups of Miniature Marshmallows

1/4 a Cup of Butter

**Plastic Bag** 

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Wash your hands.
- 2. Crush the Oreo Cookies into small pieces.
- 3. Place butter and Marshmallows in microwavable cauldron or bowl and heat in microwave on high for 1 minute.
- 4. Stir Butter and Marshmallows until smooth.
- 5. Add in Crushed Oreos and stir well.
- 6. Roll into small Coal shaped cookies, and flatten to create a Coal shape.
- 7. Allow them to cool completely before storing.
- 8. Store in airtight storage container.
- 9. Put them in your fridge to chill for at least an hour if you want them to taste like actual coal.
